

HOW TEAMS ADVANCE FROM THEIR AREA OR SECTION TO THE DISTRICT TOURNAMENT IN JUNIOR VOLLEYBALL

Last year we made changes to the formula we used to select those schools who are eligible to advance beyond their local league to the District Tournament. This was done to eliminate play in games at the Junior level.

By increasing the number of teams to 12 each school will get 10 games (5 per line)
At the same time the round games would be decreased to 17 for a total of 170 pts.

The playoff structure will stay the same3 from each pool
The quarter final round goes to 17 and then the semis and finals go to 25

Area 1 - 3 schools chosen

- Tier 1 - Champ of 1A , Champ of 1BC, Finalist of 1BC

Tier 2 - Champ of 1BC , finalist of 1BC, top semifinalist of 1BC (1A does not have any tier 2 schools in the present structure that participates in VB)... to choose the top semi finalist look at the season standings ..if they are tied look at the match between them, if they are tied look at the total scores for the 4 games played, if tied use total scores from A line games, if tied use total scores from B line games etc. until tie is broken)

Area 2 - 3 schools chosen

Tier 1 champ of 2BC, finalist of 2BC, if McKay from 2A wins 2A tournament , they go - if they don't then top semi finalist from 2BC goes - use 1BC formula

Tier 2 champ of 2BC, finalist of 2BC , champ of 2A tournament - if McKay wins tournament then finalist of tournament goes

Area 3AB - 2 schools chosen (only 2 as they are only 2/3 of an area)

Tier 1 - champ of 3AB goes, finalist of 3AB goes

Tier 2 - champ of 3AB goes, finalist of 3AB goes

Area 3C, 4ABC - 4 schools chosen (one and 1/3 sections)

Tier 1 - champ of 3C,4ABC advances, finalist of 3C,4ABC advances, 2 semi finalist advances.....playoffs should happen as it does affect their seeding

Tier 2. - champ of tier 2 advances, finalist of tier 2 advances; top semi finalist of tier 2 advances - use 1BC formula and champ of tier 3 advances If no Tier exists then both semi finalists will advance

By doing it this way we will have no play in games and leagues are not on as tight a timeline

we also have a co ed tournament for teams that do not have separate boys or girls team

we have a co ed league in area 3c,4abc

once we see the total number of teams within the board that played either in the 3C,4ABC co ed league or in a boys league in 1A, 1BC, 2A, 2BC,3AB then the structure of the co ed tournament will be determined

any school that formed a co ed team and played in the boys league and advanced to the playoffs within that league can not advance to the boys district tournament (either tier) but rather would be eligible to advance to the co ed tournament
